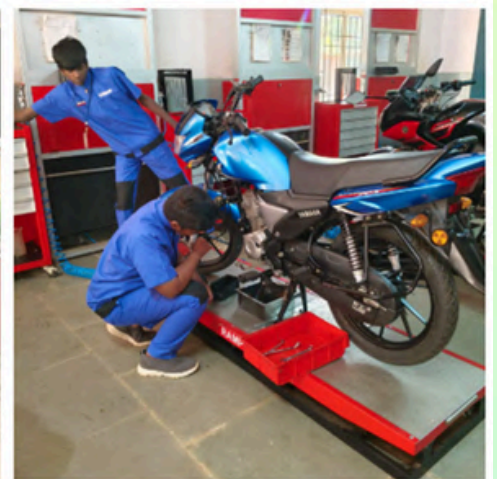

# Recognition for Clean Campus & Sustainability

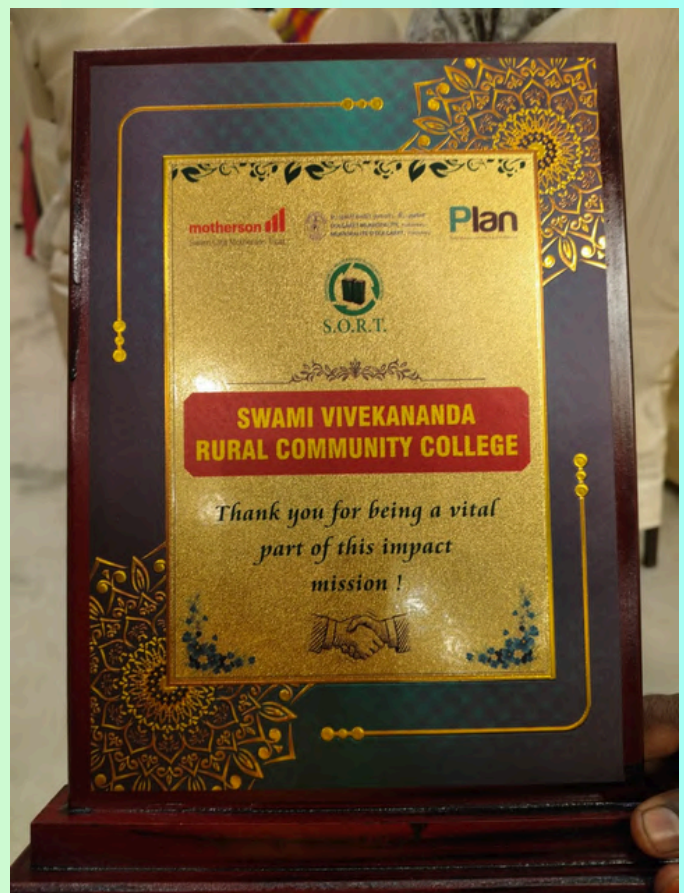
A proud moment for our college!

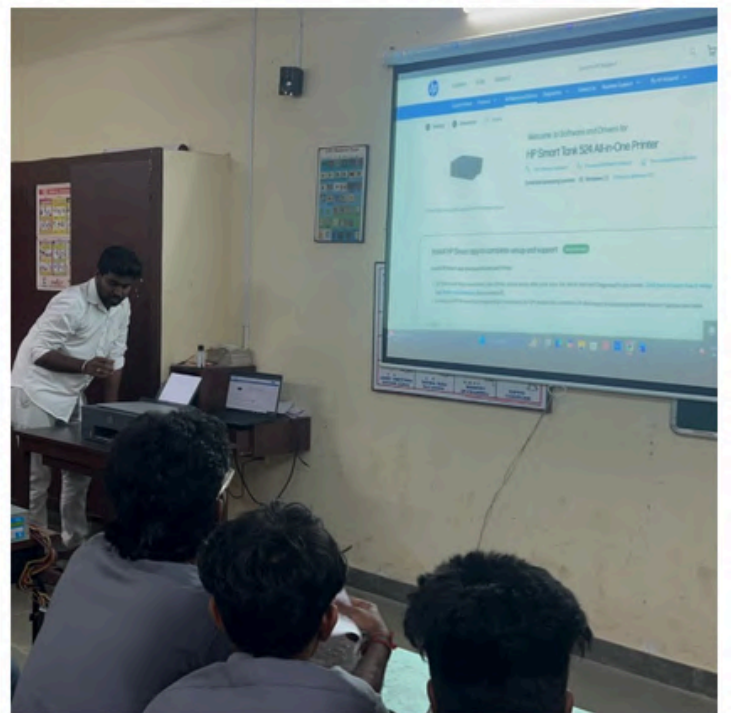
## Guru Air Con Systems, Puducherry

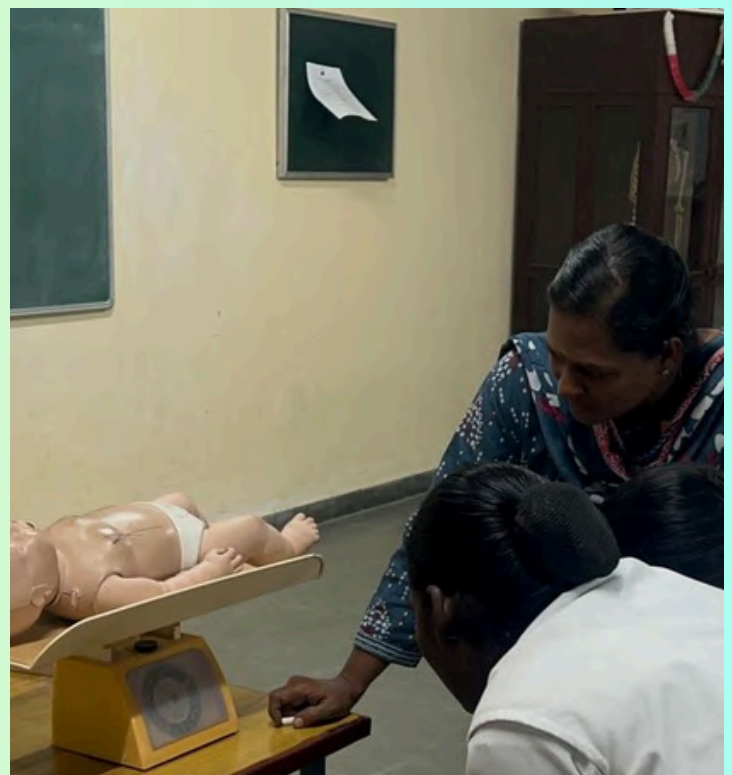
